Ministry of Public Health Notification

(No.361) B.E.2556 (2013)

Re: Food Containing Pesticide Residues (No.2)

It is appropriate to amend the Ministry of Public Health Notification entitled “Food Containing Pesticide Residues”

By virtue of articles 5 paragraph 1, 6(2), 6(3) and 6(9) of the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979), which restricts person rights and liberties in conjunction with articles 29, 33, 41, 43 and 45 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, the Minister of Public Health issued the Notification of Ministry of Public Health which under the advisory of The Food Committee, as follows:

Clause 1 In this notification, “Rice” means non-glutinous rice or glutinous rice from which the husk has been removed, packaged or made up in advance in a container, ready for retail sale to the consumer.

Clause 2 The following pesticide residues are added to the annex 1 : Maximum Residue Limit (MRL) of Notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Title : Food Containing Pesticide Residues, issued on 14th April 2011, as follows:

Clause 3 This notification is effective the day after its announcement in the Royal Thai Government Gazette.
