NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC HEALTH
(NO. 428), B.E. 2564 (2021)
ISSUED UNDER THE FOOD ACT, B.E. 2522 (1979)
RE: STANDARDS OF FOOD CONTAINING TETRAHYDROCANNABINOL
AND CANNABIDIOL CONTAMINANTS

Whereas it is expedient to prescribe standards of food containing tetrahydrocannabinol and cannabidiol contaminants for certain types of food which may be contaminated due to the ingredients or production process with a view to protecting consumers' safety;

By virtue of the provisions of section 5 paragraph one and section 6 (2), (3) and (9) of the Food Act, B.E. 2522 (1979), the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the notification as follows.

Clause 1. Food containing tetrahydrocannabinol and cannabidiol contaminants must conform to the standards whereby the contaminants detected shall not exceed the maximum limits as follows:

1. Total tetrahydrocannabinol (Total THC)

Caffeinated beverages

Conditions

(1) “Not detected” means detecting less than 0.1 milligrams per kilogram for the test and analysis of total tetrahydrocannabinol (Total THC) which is the content of the substances Δ^9 -THC, Δ^8 -THC and THC content, or less than 0.2 milligrams per kilogram for the test and analysis of cannabidiol (CBD).

Clause 2. This Notification shall come into force as from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.*
