Notification of the Ministry of Public Health

(No. 200) B.E. 2543 (2000)

Re: Sauces in Sealed Containers

It deems appropriate to amend the notification of Ministry of Public Health, Re: Labelling of sauces in sealed containers.

By the virtue of provisions of Sections 5 and 6 (7) and (10) of the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979), in which contain provisions in relation to the restriction of Rights and Liberties of the Persons, in respect of which Section 29 and in conjunction with Section 35, Section 48 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of provisions of law; the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the notification as follows:

Clause 1. The notification of the Ministry of Public Health No. 79 B.E. 2527 (1984), Re: Labelling of sauces in sealed containers, dated 2nd January B.E. 2527 (1984) shall be repealed.

Clause 2. Sauces in Sealed Container is prescribed food to have label.

Clause 3. Sauce means liquid, viscous or dry product, which may or may not be homogenized and intend to be used as condiment, such as:

(1) Various kinds of sauces, except for some sauces and food seasoning derived from the hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein, according to the related of such notifications of the Ministry of Public Health.

(2) Tao Chiew (Fermented soybean).

(3) Other kind of sauces.

Clause 4. Sauces in Sealed Containers producers or importers for sales shall follow to the notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Production processes, production equipments and foods storages.

Clause 5. Labels of sauces in sealed containers shall follow to the notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Labels.

Clause 6. Food Registration or Food Labelling, which are issued to follow the notification of the Ministry of Public Health No. 79 B.E. 2527 (1984), Re: Labelling of sauces in sealed containers, dated 2nd January B.E. 2527 (1984), prior to this notification, shall be valid for 2 years as from the come into force date of this notification.

Clause 7. Sauces in Sealed Containers producers or importers, whose permits issued prior to this notification, shall apply for food serial number within one year as from the come into force date of this notification. After applying for food serial number, the sauces in sealed containers producers or importers shall be abated from stipulation in Clause 4 for a period of 2 years after this notification come into force. As a result, the remaining labels are allowed to be used until last but not exceeding to 2 years after this notification come into force.

Clause 8. This notification shall come into force after 180 days as from the day following date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
