NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC HEALTH

NO. 135 [B.E.2534(1991)]

Re : Drinking Water in Sealed Container (No.2)

Whereas it is deemed appropriate to amend the stipulations on the subject of quality or standards of drinking water in sealed container,

By virtue of Section 5 and Section 6 (1),(2) and (6) of the Foods Act B.E.2522(1979), the Minister of Public Health hereby notifies that :

No.1. The provisions of (e) of (2) of No.3 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health No.61 [B.E.2524(1981)] Re: Drinking Water in Sealed Container, dated 7th September 1991, shall be repealed and replaced by the following :

"(e) cadmium not more than 0.005 mg. per 1 litre of drinking water."

No.2. The provisions of (i) and (j) of (2) No.3 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health No.61 [B.E.2524(1991)] Re: Drinking Water in Sealed Container, dated 7th September 1991, shall be repealed and replaced by the following :

"(i) iron not more than 0.3 mg. per 1 litre of drinking water;

(j) lead not more than 0.05 mg. per 1 litre of drinking water;"

No. 3 The following shall be added as (s),(t) and (u) of (2) of No. 3 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health No.61 [B.E.2524 (1991)] Re: Drinking Water in Sealed Container, dated 7th September 1981:

"(s) aluminium not more than 0.2 mg. per 1 litre of drinking water;

(t) ABS (alkylbenzene sulfonate) not more than 0.2 mg. per 1 litre of drinking water;

(u) cyanide not more than 0.1 mg. per 1 litre of drinking water."

No.4. The persons who have been granted Food Recipe Registration Certificate or the persons who have been authorized to use food label under the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health No.61 [B.E.2524 (1981) Re: Drinking Water in Sealed Container dated 7th September 1981 prior to the enforcement date of this Notification shall submit application for amendment of the particulars so that they be in accordance with this Notification within one hundred and eighty days from the date of enforcement of this Notification, and upon the said application having been submitted, the food recipe registration certificate or the old food label may still be in use until the approval is granted or until the person granting permission notifies them of the disapproval.

This Notification shall be enforced on and from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
